For Single / Multi-Family Dwellings

Place these items mixed together in a clear recycling bag.

Materials to be Commingled	What do I recycle? <i>Place in blue bag</i>	Cleaning & Preparation	What can NOT be recycled? <i>Place in clear bag</i>

<p>Aluminum, Tin, & Steel Cans</p> 	<p>Cans and Food Cans</p> <p>ONLY</p>	<p>Rinse Clean</p> <p>(flattening is optional)</p>	<p>Foil & Bottle Caps,</p> <p>Cardboard sided juice cans,</p> <p>Aerosol Cans,</p> <p>& Paint Cans</p>
<p>Plastic</p> 	<p>Milk, Soda, and Detergent Bottles,</p> <p>other Bottles Marked:</p> <p>#1 PETE</p> <p>#2 HDPE</p>	<p>Rinse Clean</p> <p>Remove and discard lids in Trash.</p> <p>Crush Bottles.</p>	<p>Plastic Oil Bottles (Cooking Oil, Motor Oil),</p> <p>Yogurt and Ice Cream Containers, Food Containers,</p> <p>Styrofoam, Plastic Cups and Film, Hard Plastic (toys, pails, etc),</p> <p>Medical Bottles and Syringes</p>

Other Recyclable Items NOT in a blue recycling bag.

Mixed Paper Materials	What do I recycle?	What can NOT be recycled?
<p>Newspapers & Magazines</p> 	<p>Tie with string or twine in both directions or place together in a brown paper grocery bag.</p> <p>Bundles can be no larger than 8" high.</p>	<p>JUNK MAIL</p> <p>Bathroom waste paper (towels, toilet paper), Carbon Paper, Cellophane, Cloth, Cork Foil, Polystyrene Styrofoam, Waxed anything, Candy Wrappers, Napkins, Paper Cups, Styrofoam Cups, Styrofoam Packaging, Paper Food Containers, Photographs, Fiberboard, Labels and Label Backings.</p>
<p>Cardboard</p> 	<p>Cut into 3' X 3' sections and bind</p>
